

## MATT REVERSIBLE CABLE SCARF & HAT



### **Knitting Needs**

**Scarf** - Black Hills Corilana dye free natural coloured 100% wool - 300g

**Hat** - Black Hills Corilana dye free natural coloured 100% wool - 150g

(Yarn amounts given are approximate and are based on average requirements.)

### **Scarf**

1 pair 5.50mm knitting needles

1 crochet hook (optional) for adding fringe

### **Hat**

4 x 4.00mm dpn's or short (40cm circular needle)

5.00mm circular needle

Row marker

### **Both**

1 Cable needle

Wool needle for sewing in ends

*Aran*

### **Tension**

**This is not important.**

### **Experience Level**

## SCARF - INSTRUCTIONS

**Abbreviation : C6B:** Slip next 3 knit sts on cable needle to back of work, knit next 3sts then 3sts from cable needle.

**Cut 42 x 30cm lengths of yarn for fringing before you commence knitting  
Using 5.50mm needles, cast on 44sts**

### Pattern Block

**Row 1:** K7, (P6, K6) 3 times, K1  
**Row 2:** K1, (P6, K6) 3 times, P6, K1  
**Row 3:** K1, (C6B, P6) 3 times, C6B, K1  
**Row 4:** K1, (P6, K6) 3 times, P6, K1  
**Row 5:** K7, (P6, K6) 3 times, K1  
**Row 6:** Repeat row 2  
**Row 7:** Repeat row 1  
**Row 8:** K1 (P6, C6B), 3 times, P6, K1

Repeat these 8 rows for approx 2m or until you run out of wool, then cast off (preferably on row 1 or 4).  
Sew in ends.

## HAT - INSTRUCTIONS

With either 4.00mm dpn's or short circular needle, cast on 106sts. Close round and mark with row marker.

**Round 1 :** K1, P1 to end

**Round 2 :** K1, P1 to end

Continue in single rib for 8cm (3")

**Next round,** rib 9, inc in 9<sup>th</sup> stitch, repeat to last 5sts, rib to end (117sts)

Change to 5.00mm circular needle or dpn's and work as follows:

**Next round:** P7, K6, repeat to end

Repeat this row 3 times more.

### Pattern Block:

**Row 1 :** P7, C6B, repeat to end

**Rows 2 - 8 :** P7, K6, repeat to end

Commencing row 1 of hat pattern block, repeat 3 more times (4 repeats in all) **NB:** If you would like a longer hat, add extra pattern sequences - each pattern sequence measures 3cm (1¼").

Repeat row 1 of pattern sequence.

Keeping continuity of pattern sequence proceed as follows:

**Next round:** (P1, P2tog, P1, P2tog, P1). Repeat decreases in purl blocks to end.

Work 1 round

**Next round:** (P2tog, P1, P2tog). Repeat decreases in purl blocks to end of round.

Work 1 round.

**Next round:** (P3tog). Repeat decreases in purl blocks to end of round.

At this point you might need to change back to dpn's if working on a circular needle (or use the magic loop if you know how to use it).

**Next round:** (P1, K2tog, K2, K2tog) Repeat to end of round.

Work 1 round:

**Next round:** (P1, K2tog twice). Repeat to end of round.

Work 1 round:

**Next round:** (P1, K2tog) repeat to end of round.

**Next round:** K2tog to end of round.

Cut yarn leaving an end long enough to thread through all sts, pull up and fasten securely.

Sew in all ends.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Black Hills wool should be carefully hand washed in warm water, rinsed in a small amount of fabric conditioner, rolled in a towel (or spun very gently in a washing machine) to remove the excess water and dried flat, to bring out the softness in the finished garment. This washing can be done before stitching up a garment or after the garment is completed.

Do not press hats and scarves.
